#### **ANTECEDENTES**

Aloha 'Āina Kalaepōhaku will bring together kaiāulu to mālama from mauka to makai. With a focus on Aloha 'Āina as the vehicle to educate on sustainability, our event will involve hands-on service and experiential learning by way of existing projects within the campus māla, pālolo stream, and invasive limu removal at Ka'alawai beach . Aloha 'Āina Kalaepōhaku will also feature prominent figures as

speakers and workshop/breakout session leaders after morning service activities are complete.
