Given the complexity and number of processes that will contribute to the development of the Post-2015 Development Agenda, United Nations Institute for

Training and Research (UNITAR) is organizing a series of interactive technical briefings for members of delegations and other government officials at the United Nations in New York, and later in Geneva.
