ANTECEDENTES

At the request of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, UNITAR proposes a three-day workshop in the second half of January 2016 that will provide participants with an introduction to Diplomatic Protocol, Public Diplomacy and Media Relations with the aim of equipping participants with the skills, knowledge and tools to both campaign and raise awareness on UNIDO's activities and general mandate.

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Demonstrate knowledge of the skills and techniques required by public diplomacy practitioners vis-à-vis the media and other stakeholders;
