BACKGROUND

Cervical cancer screening in Rwanda could not gain momentum as it was done by oncologists in the hospitals until date. Now the Ministry of Health of Rwanda is decentralizing cervical cancer screening services to the district hospitals and to the health centers therein.

Bugesera is now the 8th district in Rwanda whose nurses are invited to this training to build their capacity to conduct cervical and breast cancer screening and offer precancerous treatment by thermal ablation in health centres and LEEP

in the district hospitals.

EVENT OBJECTIVES

Two groups of training to be conducted back-to-back and facilitated by 6 trainers:

- Cervical & breast cancer screening training group: will have 19 nurses and doctors
- Cervical cancer and breast data reporting from health facilities henceforth, Mozima application: will have 17 data managers
