As industries face increasing social and workforce transformation challenges — including migration flows, labour inclusion, diversity, and social vulnerability — there is a need to strengthen institutional capacity to create safe, inclusive, and opportunity-driven workplaces.

Through CIFAL Curitiba and Sistema FIEP, the programme seeks to connect industry competitiveness with social responsibility, aligning economic growth with human-centred development principles.



- Strengthen corporate awareness on diversity and inclusion
- Support integration of vulnerable populations into the labour market
- Promote safe and respectful workplace environments
