● Within the framework of actions aimed at strengthening the institutional capacities of local governments in the area of occupational risk prevention, **the Dominican Municipal League**, in coordination with **UN/CIFAL Dominican Republic** and the Dominican **Institute for Prevention and Protection**

**against Occupational Risks (IDOPPRIL)**, developed a national day of Regional Training Workshops on Occupational Safety and Health aimed at representatives of municipalities and municipal districts of the Dominican Republic.
